Key Moves (Summary)

- Referencing shows where your ideas come from and gives credit to original authors.
- It helps avoid plagiarism and boosts the credibility of your work.
- Different referencing styles exist (e.g., Harvard) — which is the one we require.
- Include in-text citations *and* a reference list at the end.
- Keep track of sources as you research — use digital tools or note systems.
- Don't guess! Use guides, tutor help, or referencing generators if unsure.
