ARI Playsheet #06: Game Changer – Steps to Better Academic Writing

Key Moves (Summary)

- Academic writing is formal, clear, and evidence-based — not like texting or casual speech.
- Plan before you write: outline your structure and main points.
- Stick to the point — avoid filler and waffle.
- Use clear paragraphing (PEEL: Point, Evidence, Explanation, Link).
- Support your arguments with references and examples.
- Always proofread — grammar and clarity matter just as much as content.
